★ The **Book Club** Classes consist of the following


- 1. Students read four books over the course of the summer.

The listed books are subjected to change and books may be added depending on the class.











Courses

- Course A: SAT English, SAT Math, and Practice tests

- Course A: ACE will keep tracking students' scores and updating scores to parents. Additionally, ACE will provide academic suggestions for the improvement.
